Introduction

In India Dodgeball game was introduced in 2005, and from then onwards many Nationals were conducted in all the three categories Senior, Sub Junior and Junior in various states for the development of Dodgeball Game in India.

Our state team has won many championships in various categories.

In 2019, the Indian Dodgeball Federation has got International Affiliation from World Dodgeball Federation whose head office is at Canada.

Due to Covid 19 Pandemic the tournaments and matches were not conducted in accordance with the covid rules of the Indian Government.

Now again after covid pandemic the Federation has started its activities in the country by organizing the championships/ tournaments in our country where about 16 to 18 states have participated in various categories. Our Karnataka State team is a strong contender and have won many championships in all the three categories organized.

In about 19 to 20 Indian states Dodgeball is played and are affiliated to the Indian Dodgeball Federation. In Southern India, Karnataka, Goa, Pondicherry, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh are affiliated units of the Indian Dodgeball Federation and are strong contenders.

In Karnataka, Nationals were organized and our state players have outperformed the other states

Now for the first time the Indian teams are playing with international teams for the Asia Pacific International Dodgeball Cup 2023 along with 20 other countries with 140 teams and 2100 participants. Our teams will be the strong opponents for other teams as they are getting coached for the Dodgeball International Championship both on the field and off field at BGS Residential School, Sharavathinagar, Shivamogga from 16th to 22nd May 2023.

Our teams will be departing to Malaysia on $23^{\rm rd}$ and the matches will be played from $25^{\rm th}$ to $28^{\rm th}$ May 2023 at Shah Alam Sports Complex, Panasonic, Malaysia
